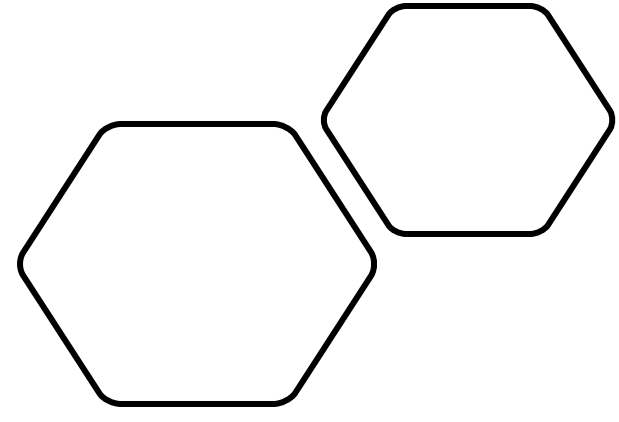

- Lots of changes took place since I have joined this organisation.

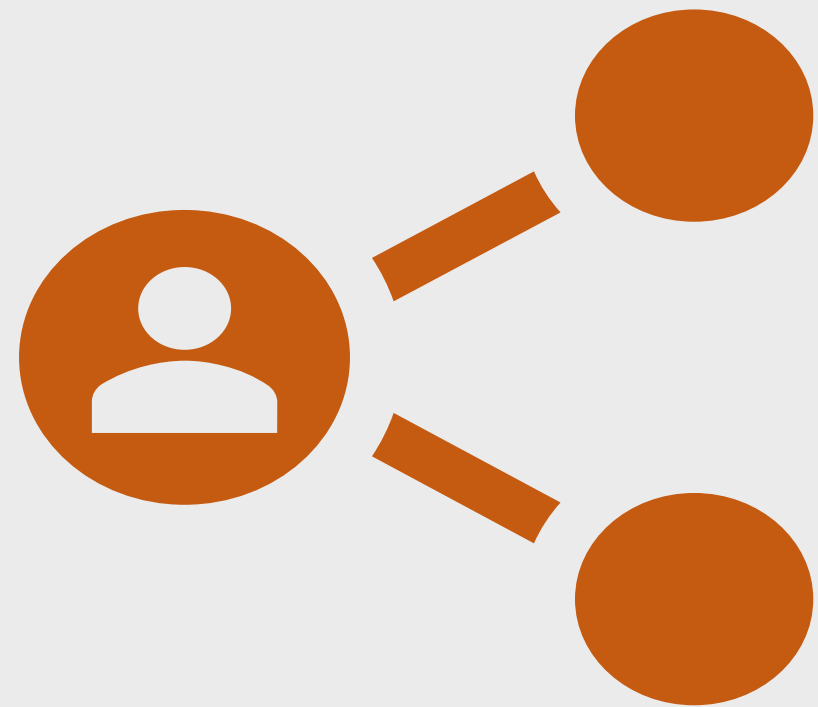
RULE NO.4
