

Maharashtra, Gujarat brace for 'severe cyclone' tomorrow

NEW DELHI, MUMBAL JUNE 1

BARELY A fortnight after super cyclone Amphan, one of the strongest cyclones the country has seen in the last few decades, hit West Bengal, Odisha and Bangladesh, a cyclonic storm has been forming in the Arabian Sea over the I24 hours, which is predicted to intensify into a severe cyclone, 'Nisarga', and make landfall by Wednesday evening, according to the Met department.

Nisanga's impact is likely to be felt most strongly in Mumbai. Thane, Palghar, Raigad districts, with wind speed up to 105-115 km per hour gusting to 125 km perbour around the point of landfall, according to India Meteorological Department (IMD) authorities.

It is expected to land anywhere between Haribareshwar, south of Mumbai Maharashtra's Raigad district, and Daman, located on the southern

Discovered alive in Indian waters for the first time

Researchers at the Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute (CMFRI) have found a rare fish from Sethukarai coast in the Gulf of Mannar.

Camouflaged within the seagrass meadows, the band-tail scorpionfish (Scorpaenospsis neglecta), well-known for its stinging venomous spines and ability to change colour, was found during an exploratory survey of the seagrass ecosystem.

This was the first time that the particular species was found alive in Indian waters, said a press release.

The fish has the ability to change colour and blend survey, this species was first sighted as a coral skeleton.

On first look, its appearance was totally confusing and we doubted if it was a fish or fossilised coral skeleton covered with bivalve shells.

Colour changing

"It started changing when we disturbed it by touching a dead coral fragment. Within four seconds, the skin of the fish changed from white to mottled black colour," said R. Jeyabaskaran, senior scientist at CMFRI, who led the team of researchers.



The fish is called 'scorpionfish' because its spines contain neurotoxic venom.

Neurotoxic

"When the spines pierce an individual, the venom gets injected immediately and it can be extremely painful," Mr. Jeyabaskaran said, adding that eating the fish would lead to death.

The specimen has been deposited in the National Marine Biodiversity Museum of the CMFRI. The research work was published in the latest issue of the journal Current Science.



- It is bounded to the northeast by Rameswaram (island), Adam's (Rama's) Bridge (a chain of shoals), and Mannar Island.



• It is a leading tropical marine fisheries research institute in the world, headquartered in Kochi, Kerala.



JERUSALEM

Jerusalem's Al-Aqsa mosque compound reopened to Muslim worshippers and visitors on Sunday after a two-and-a-half month CO-VID-19 closure, but authorities imposed some precautions. The resumption of prayers at Islam's third-holiest site capped a sombre period for Jerusalem's Muslims, who this year marked the holy fasting month of Ramzan and the Id holiday without their usual daily visits to Al-Aqsa and the adjoining Dome of the Rock. The Council of Islamic Wagf cited the slowed local spread of COVID-19 in reopening the compound's iconic shrines, which shut on March 15.

Temple Mount/Noble Sanctuary

Jews call the 35-acre compound Temple Mount because it was the site of their Second Temple, which was destroyed by the Romans. Al-Agsa Mosque


The third holiest in Islam after Mecca and Medina in Saudi Arabia.

Western Wall


The last remnant of the Second Temple compound and one of the holiest sites in Judaism.

Bengal's grand old buildings bear the brunt of Amphan

Centuries-old St. Andrew's Church, Serampore College, and Dupleix Palace among those damaged

When super cyclone Amplum swept through south Bergal last week, it not only flattened thousands of houses, but also severely damaged some of its centuriesold heritage structures.

Palaces, mosques, temples or offices depicting istem's footprint on the Bengal frontier to architectural traditions of European colonialism, gardens from the time of 19th century resurgence in Bengal's cultural landscape to the recently renovated lititish-era buildings all bore the brunt.

China's Opposition to THAAD

Recently, China has issued a statement reiterating its long-standing objections to the presence of the USA's THAAD missile defence system in South Korea. This comes after the reports of an overnight operation to bring in new, replacement interceptor missiles to the USA base in South Korea.

• It is an acronym for Terminal High Altitude Area Defense, a transportable, ground-based antiballistic missile defence system.

 This system has been designed and manufactured by the USA company Lockheed Martin.

• In 2017, when North Korea test-fired a few missiles in the direction of USA bases in Japan, the USA moved the missile systems to its army base in Osan, South Korea.

The THAAD system provides the critical capability to defend against short and medium ranged ballistic missiles.
















INTERCEPTING A MISSILE




