Trump invites Modi for G-7 summit

Leaders discuss tensions along LAC

NEW DELHI

U.S. President Donald Trump on Tuesday invited Prime Minister Narendra Modi to the next G-7 summit to be hosted by the U.S.


Both the leaders also discussed the current tensions along the Line of Actual Control (LAC) near Ladakh and the COVID-19 pandemic.

"President Trump spoke about the U.S. Presidency of the Group of Seven, and conveyed his desire to expand the ambit of the grouping beyond the existing membership, to include other important countries including India. In this context he extended an invitation to Prime Minister Modi to attend the next G-7 Summit," said a government press release.

Sources here indicated that India is studying the gesture and will examine if the invite is aimed at making India a permanent part of the global high table at the G-7 or its redesigned shape as G-11.

In the next three years, India is expected to play a key role in global diplomatic arena because of its three-year term at the executive board of the World Health Organization which is a crucial responsibility because of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Hong Kong bans Tiananmen vigil for first time in 30 years

Police cite the pandemic as reason for imposing restrictions

Hong Kong police on Monday banned an upcoming vigil marking the Tiananmen crackdown anniversary citing the COVID-19 pandemic, the first time the gathering has been halted in three decades.

The candlelight June 4 vigil usually attracts huge crowds and is the only place on Chinese soil where such a major commemoration of the anniversary is still allowed.

Last year's gathering was especially large and came just a week before seven months of pro-democracy protests and clashes exploded onto the city's streets, sparked initially by a plan to allow extraditions to the authoritarian mainland.

But police rejected permission for this year's rally saying it would "constitute a major threat to the life and




Recalling history: A Hong Kong pro-democracy protester waving a British colonial flag during a rally at a shopping mall in the city on Monday. *APP

Alliance which has organised every vigil since 1990.

'Can allow non-profit organisations to list on social stock exchanges'

Direct listing can be done via issuance of bonds: SEBI group

A working group constituted by the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) on social stock exchanges has recommended allowing non-profit organisations to directly list on such platforms while allowing certain tax incentives to encourage participation on the platform.

The idea of a social stock exchange (SSE) for listing of social enterprise and voluntary organisations was mooted by Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman while presenting the Union Budget 2019-20.

According to a release issued by the capital markets regulator, the group has re-




commended allowing nonprofit organisations to directly list through issuance of bonds while recommending a range of funding avenues, including some of the existing mechanisms such as Social Venture Funds (SVFs) under Alternative Investment Funds (AIFs).

"There is a great opportunity to unlock funds from donors, philanthropic foundations and CSR spenders, in the form of zero coupon zero principal bonds. These bonds will be listed on the SSE," stated the report.

The group has also suggested a new minimum reporting standard for organisations that raise funds on social stock exchanges.

It also suggested that forprofit social enterprises be allowed to list on the platform but with enhanced reporting requirements. The working group has also suggested that the social stock exchange can be housed within the existing national bourses like the BSE and the National Stock Exchange.

"This will help the SSE leverage existing infrastructure and client relationships of the exchanges to onboard investors, donors, and social enterprises [for-profit and non-profit]," said the report.



Social Stock Exchange



- Social Stock Exchange is a platform which allows investors to buy shares in social enterprises vetted by an official exchange.
- Social Stock Exchange would provide a platform where investors would invest in social enterprises authorised by the exchange. Such enterprises would have to share with the public the details of their activities and investments in a transparent manner.

Japan city to ban phone use while walking

It is a scene repeated the world over: pedestrians glued to their phones while walking, causing collisions and sometimes accidents. No more, says one Japanese city.

Officials in Yamato city, near Tokyo, on Monday submitted a bill to the city assembly to stop people from using their phones while walking. "The number of people using smartphones has rapidly increased and so have the number of accidents" in the densely populated area, city official Masaaki Yasumi said. "We want to prevent that," he said.


But Mr. Yasumi said there will be no punishment for those unable to tear themselves away from their screens in the street. Posters and messages will inform citizens of the rule, expected to take from next month.

COVID-19 strikes fear in Bru refugee camp in Tripura

Man who travelled from Chennai tests positive

The novel coronavirus has struck in a relief camp for about 15,000 displaced Bru tribal people in Tripura's Kanchanpur subdivision.

A man from the Damcherra area of North Tripura district's Panisagar subdivision bordering Mizoram was prescribed home quarantine after he reached Agartala in May-end. But his swab sample tested COVID-19 positive the day after he reached his wife's house at the Naisingpara relief camp on the morning of May 30.

The camp is about 185 km northeast of Agartala.

"We have transported him to Agartala for treat-

ment and his close contacts are being tested now," Kanchanpur's Sub-Divisional Magistrate Chandni Chandran told *The Hindu* on Monday.

"He came from Chennai, stayed at an Agartala quarantine facility for less than two days and gave his address as Damcherra but came to his wife's house at Naisingpara without informing anyone," she added.

The man is said to be a local Reang (another name for Bru) tribal although Damcherra, along with Naisingpara, has one of seven relief camps for some 35,000 Bru people displaced from Mizoram since 1997 due to ethnic clashes.

North Tripura district officials did not rule out the possibility of health teams not ensuring proper home quarantine for the Reang man.

District health officials said they have tracked the driver of a jeep who transported the man to Naisingpara along with two others. The other two were dropped at Damcherra.


Anchoring ties with Canberra the virtual way

'Rozgar Setu' for skilled workers in M.P.



 Madhya Pradesh has announced the launch of the 'Rozgar Setu' scheme which would help secure employment for skilled workers who have returned to their native places from urban areas.



 Madhya Pradesh is the first state to devise such a work plan. The attempt is to provide work to the maximum number of returned skilled workers.

Kerala issues data security guidelines

 The government had contracted with Sprinklr, a U.S.based data analytics firm, to crunch the health data of citizens to understand how the pandemic would behave in the State.

 The Opposition had approached the Kerala High Court, accusing the Kerala Government of having used the outbreak as a cover to allow the U.S.-based firm to "harvest and monetise" the medical information of the State's population.



 The Kerala Government has issued guidelines for the collection of personal information following the Sprinklr controversy. The government aims to address some of the points raised by the HC judgment.

The guidelines mandate that agencies and departments should collect sensitive personal data of citizens only with their legally recorded informed consent.




PM CARES (28 March, 2020)not within the ambit of RTI Act: PMO

• The Prime Minister's Office (PMO) has refused to disclose details on the creation and operation of the Prime Minister's Citizen Assistance and Relief in Emergency Situations (PM CARES) Fund under an RTI applicant claiming that the fund is "not a public authority" within the ambit of the RTI Act, 2005.



- Formed as charitable trust in 2020 with PM Modi as chairman
- Has Defence Minister, Home Minister & Finance Minister as members
- Eminent persons from fields of science, health, law, public work etc can be nominated
- PM CARES trust will take decisions on allocations and selecting beneficiaries with collective wisdom of ministers & nominated members
- Donations to PM CARES by companies & individuals are completely tax
- Donations by companies classified as CSR under Companies Act 2013
- No clarity from Modi govt yet on who will audit PM CARES financial accounts



- Formed by Nehru in 1948 before Constitution came into force
- In 1948 Indian National Congress president was a member of managing committee among others
- Since 1985 Rajiv Gandhi govt gave complete control of PMNRF to PMO
- Since 1985, the decision to allocate money and selecting beneficiaries was done only at 'discretion & on recommendations of the PM'
 - Donations to PMNRF are also completely tax exempt
- Donations by corporates also classified as CSR under Companies Act
- Accounts not audited by Comptroller & Auditor General (CAG) of India




