D sits opposite X and Z is not the neighbour of C.

Directions (6-10): Read the information carefully and answer the given question:

Ten people are sitting in two parallel rows containing five people each in such a way that there is equal distance between adjacent person. In row 1-H, I, J, K and L are seated and all of them are facing south and in row 2-R, S, T, U and V are seated and are facing north (but not necessarily in the same order). One seat in each row is Vacant. In the given seating arrangement each person seated in a row faces another member of the other row. Each of them belongs to a different country viz, USA, UK, Thailand, Myanmar, Bhutan, Singapore, Dubai, China, Japan and Netherlands but not necessarily in the same order.

U sits second to the right of T and belongs to Myanmar. Only two persons sit between S and the vacant seat. S belongs neither to Bhutan nor to Thailand. L is not an immediate neighbor of J. I belongs to Netherlands. The one who belongs to Thailand faces the one who belongs to China. The one belongs to Thailand faces to one who sits second to the right of the one who faces U. J and K are not immediate neighbors. V, who belongs neither to Bhutan nor to Singapore, does not faces the vacant seat. K faces T. The vacant seat does not face each other. The vacant seat of row-1 is not beside K. T belongs neither to USA nor to China. Either T or U sits at an extreme end. R sits at one of the extreme ends. The one who belongs to USA and the one who belongs to China are immediate neighbours. The vacant seat of row-1 is not at the extreme end. I sits second to the right of H, who belongs to Japan. The one who belongs to UK faces the one who sits on the immediate right of the one who belongs to Dubai. The one who belongs to Singapore and the one who belongs to Dubai do not face each other. The vacant seat of row-2 is not beside T. J does not belong to UK.

Eight persons P, Q, R, S, T, U, V and W are sitting around a circular table. Each of them belongs to a different profession, viz Doctor, Banker, Engineer, Lawyer, Businessman, Teacher, Pharmacist and Writer, but not necessarily in the same order. Four of the persons are facing towards the centre while the remaining four are facing away from the centre.

S is third to the right of W. The one who is a Businessman is on the immediate left of S, who is not a Pharmacist. V is fourth to the left of U. Neither V nor U is an immediate neighbour of S.
