mumbai : Indian banks' bad loan ratio is expected to climb to the highest level in more than 20 years as a protracted lockdown has severely disrupted business operations and left millions of people jobless, crimping their ability to repay loans.

Protracted

Non-performing assets may rise 4 percentage points to 12.5% of total advances by March, the highest since the year ended March 31, 2000, under the baseline stress scenario, the Reserve Bank of India said in its semi-annual Financial Stability Report on Friday. It warned that if the economic conditions worsen further, the ratio may soar to 14.7%.

# From Newspapers

Infuse → *bring*

The rise in bad loans may further reduce the ability of banks, especially the weak ones, to extend credit and the government may have to infuse more funds into state-run banks to build stronger buffers that can absorb loan losses.

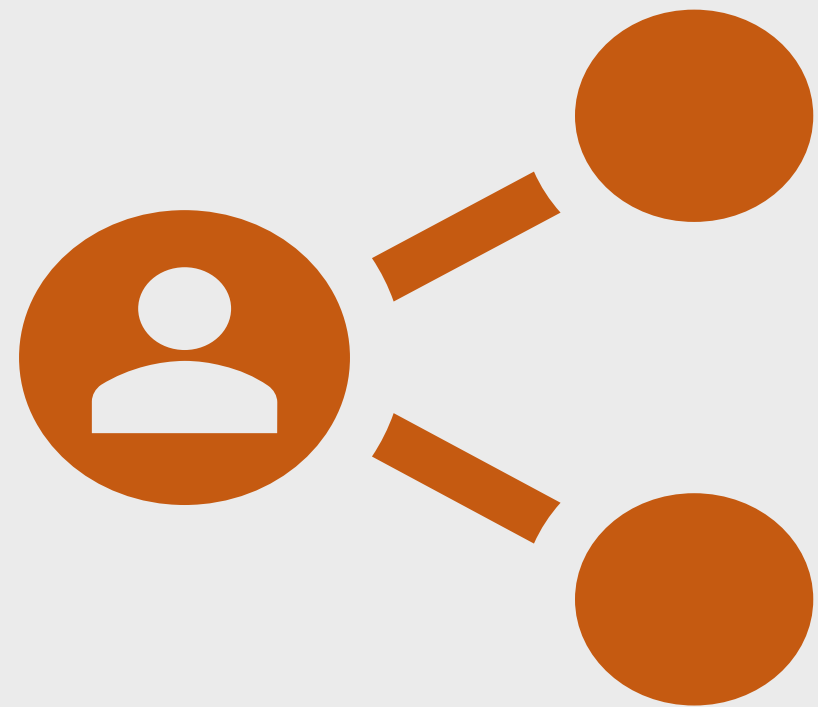

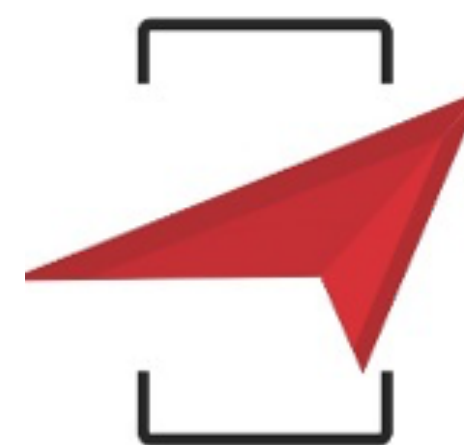
