Former Congress chief Rahul Gandhi on Sunday alleged that the BJP and its ideological parent, the Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh, control Facebook and WhatsApp in India. "Finally, the American media has come out with the truth about Facebook," Gandhi tweeted.

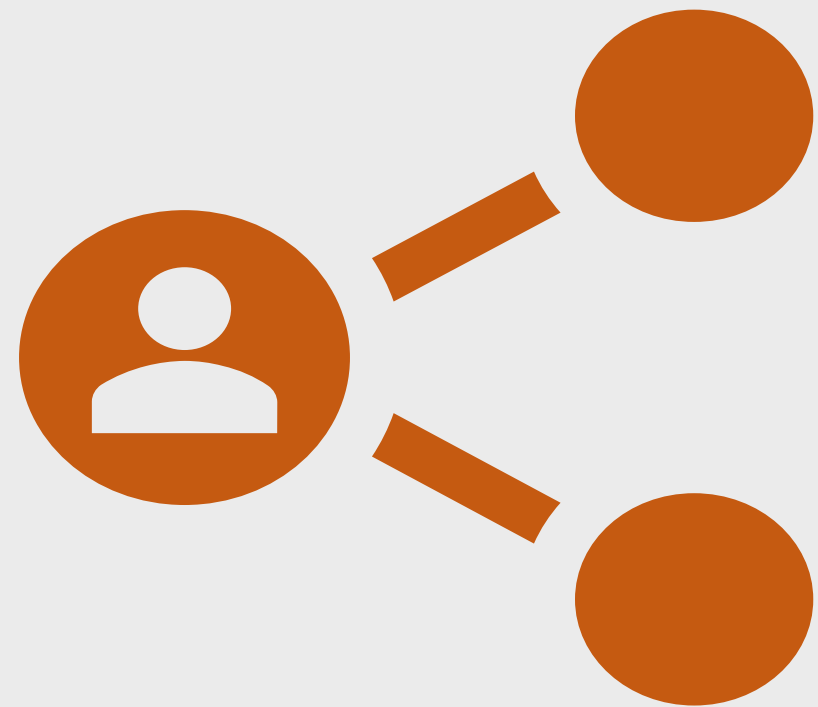

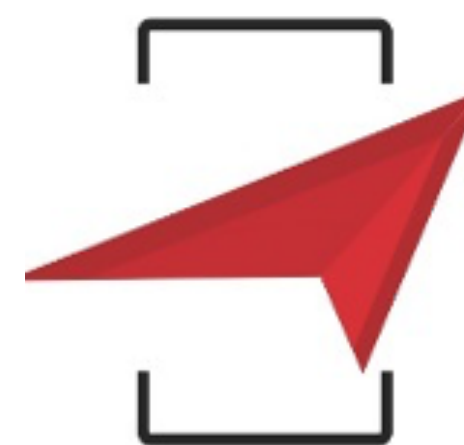
