Rajiv Gandhi Khel Ratna



 राजीव गांधी खेल रत्न जिसे आधिकारिक तौर पर 'स्पोर्ट्स एंड गेम्स में राजीव गांधी खेल रत्न पुरस्कार' के रूप में जाना जाता है, भारत गणराज्य का सर्वोच्च खेल सम्मान है।

Rajiv Gandhi Khel Ratna, officially known as the Rajiv Gandhi Khel Ratna Award in Sports & Samp; Games, is the highest sports honour of the Republic of India.

The award was started in the year 1991–92.

The first recipient of the award was Chess Grandmaster Viswanathan Anand, who was honoured for the performance in the year 1991–92.





In 2001, sport shooter Abhinav Bindra, then aged 18, became the youngest recipient of the award.



He is currently India's only individual Olympic gold medalist. His gold in the 10-meter air rifle event at the 2008 Summer Olympics was also India's first Olympic gold medal since 1980.



Rankaj Advarii is the only sportsperson to have won the award for two sports disciplines; Billiards and Snooker.





Karnam Malleswari

At the 2000 Sydney Olympics, Malleswari lifted 110 kg in the "snatch" and 130 kg in the "clean and jerk" categories for a total of 240 kg.

She won the bronze medal and became the first Indian woman to win an Olympic medal.





In 1995, she received the Rajiv Gandhi Khel Ratna, India's highest sporting honour. (First woman to get this award)







Deepa Malik, the first Indian woman to win a medal in Paralympics, was conferred the Rajiv Gandhi Khel Ratna Award by President Ram Nath Kovind.

She is the oldest sportsperson to be conferred the award.









The Sahitya Akademi was formally inaugurated by the Government of India on 12 March 1954.

Though set up by the Government, the Akademi functions as an autonomous organisation.

It was registered as a society on 7 January 1956, under the Societies Registration Act, 1860.





Writer and Congress MP Shashi Tharoor was named among the winners for Sahitya Akademi Awards. He won the prestigious literature award for his novel 'An Era of Darkness' in the creative non-fiction category in English literature.

The novel which was published in 2016 describes British rule in India.

Jnanpith Award (2019 & 2018)





Eminent Malayalam poet Akkitham has been chosen for the 55th Jnanpith Award for his outstanding contribution to Malayalam language and Poetry.

Amitab Ghosh is honoured with the 54th Jnanpith Award for his contribution to English Literature and also became the (1st English language writer) in the list as all previous winners of the prestigious award have been writers in (Indian languages).





Jnanpith Award is a literary award presented by the Bharatiya Jnanpith organization to Indian writers every year.

This was instituted in 1961 and is given only to Indian writers who write in Indian languages and English.







Facts About Jnanpith Award

The winner is given a cash prize of Rs. 11 lakh and a bronze replica of Goddess Saraswati, the Hindu goddess of learning.


Malayalam writer G Sankara Kurup in 1965 for his novel 'Odakkuzhal' (The Bamboo Flute).

The first woman writer to be awarded this award was Ashapoorna Devi, a Bengali writer, in 1976.

The organization which presents this award was founded in 1944 by industrialist and philanthropist Sahu Shanti Prasad Jain.



- The Padma Awards are announced annually on the eve of Republic Day (26th January).
- Instituted in the year 1954, it is one of the highest civilian honours of India.
- The Award seeks to recognize achievements in all fields of activities or disciplines where **an element of public service is involved**.

In 2020, the President has approved conferment of 141 Padma
