





lice stopped by and asked for documents. Dharamveer cited some faults in the papers and asked Maqbool to pay Rs 30,000 as challán.

"We gave them the money, but the cops issued a receipt of only Rs 18,000. When we asked for the remaining Rs 12,000 to be returned, they started abusing us," Maqbool mentioned in the complaint.

The police team allegedly asked Maqbool and the two others with him to leave. But when Maqbool insisted, the cops allegedly took him to the nearby police outpost and stripped him of his clothes.

The truck driver was beaten up with a belt, he alleged in the complaint.

"They used abusive words and called me a Pakistani. I was told to take off my clothes and beaten up with a belt," Maqbool said.

After being released, Maqbool called up his employer and narrated to him how he was thrashed by the cops. In the meantime, a video of the truck driver talking about the incident and pointing to his wounds was posted on social media.

After the video went vicomplaint ral, Maqbool's

was escalated and a team led

by the assistant commissioner of police started looking for him on Saturday. The cops found Maqbool in Ghaziabad, and an FIR was registered against Dharamveer for corruption.

"We have filed a case against the ASI and he is currently in custody. An inquiry will reveal the details of the incident," said KK Rao, commissioner of Faridabad police.

Dharamveer was produced in court on Saturday. Rao said the officer had denied the allegations about taking bribe and assaulting the driver.





