 - 1. General Awareness: Questions will be designed to test the ability of the candidate's General Awareness of the environment around him/her and its application to

society. The questions will be designed to test knowledge of Current Events and of such matter of everyday observation as may be expected of an educated person. The test will also include questions relating to History, Polity Constitution, Sports, Art & Culture, Geography, Economics, Everyday Science, Scientific Research, National/International Organizations /Institutions etc.

- 2. (ii) General Intellegence& Reasoning Ability: The syllabus of General Intellegence& Reasoning Ability includes questions of both verbal and non-verbal types. Test may include questions on analogies, similarities, differences, space visualization, problem solving, analysis, judgement, decision making, visual memory, discrimination, observation, relationship, concepts, arithmetical reasoning, verbal and figure classification, arithmetical number series etc.
- 3. (iii) Arthmetical & Numerical Ability: The test of Arithmetical and Numerical Abilities will cover Number Systems including questions on Simplification, Decimals, Fractions, L.C.M., H.C.F., Ratio & Proportion, Percentage, Average, Profit & Loss, Discount, Simple & Compound Interest, Mensuration, Time & Work, Time & Distance, Tables & Graphs etc. of 10th level.
 - 4&5. Hindi Language & Comprehension and English Language & Comprehension: In addition to the testing of candidate's understanding and comprehension of the English and Hindi Languages, questions on its Vocabulary, Grammar,
 - 6. Post specific subject related questions: Objective Type Multiple Choice Questions on the subject concerned as per the qualification prescribed in the Recruitment Rules for the post.

Health and determinants of health status — Basic human needs and illness and its effects on individuals. Comprehensive Nursing Care - Needs of the patient - Assessment of patient / Client — Infection control methods and practices — Biomedical waste management - Therapeutic Nursing Care and Procedures. First Aid in Emergency situations, Community Emergencies and Resource Community Emergencies - Importance of first aid and rules of first aid. Personal Hygiene - maintenance of health both physical health and mental health.

Medical Surgical Nursing: History of modern medicine and surgery — Nursing Assessment — Patho-physiological mechanism of disease — Altered immune response - Nurse's role in management of fluids and electrolyte balance. Operation theater techniques and management of patient undergoing surgery. Community Health Nursing: Concept of the community, community health and community health nursing - dimensions and indicators of health and health determinants. History and development of community health in India. Health assessment - Principles of epidemiology and epidemiology methods - Family health nursing care - Family health care settings management of minor ailments - referral system - records and reports used in community health nursing practice.
