The official notification mentions the sections to be asked in the syllabus and other details. The syllabus as per the website of the navy is:

Section	Details
General Intelligence and Reasoning	It would include questions related to Mathematical operations, Series, Odd One Out, Logical Venn Diagrams, Analogy, Word-Based Problems, Problems Solving, Drawing Inference, Coding-Decoding, Non-Verbal Reasoning, etc.
Numerical aptitude	This section will include a question on problems relating to Number Systems, Time & Work, Mensuration, Ratio and Proportion, Average, Profit and Loss, Discount, Percentage, Time and Distance, Simple and Compound Interest, Statistical Chart, Trigonometry, Geometry, etc.
General English	In addition to the testing of candidates' understanding of the English language, its vocabulary, grammar, sentence structure, synonyms, antonyms, Comprehension, and correct usage, etc.
General Awareness	The test will include questions relating to India and its neighboring countries especially pertaining to sports, history, culture, Geography, Physics, Chemistry, Computer Science, Environmental Science, Economics sense, Current Events, General policy including Indian Constitution and scientific research, etc. These questions will be such that they do not require a special study of any discipline.
